



6th Grade History and Bible Teacher at The Covenant School

Job Purpose

The Covenant School seeks a qualified, collegial, and experienced teacher of 6th grade Bible and History. In our Bible course, students carefully study the Old Testament from both a historical and literary perspective, seeking to find common themes and messages that create a coherent framework from which to understand the Holy Scriptures. Our 6th grade History course covers Post-Reconstruction era US History- September 11, 2001. This course seeks to develop historical thinking skills, reading of academic texts and primary sources, and introduces historical writing skills. 6th grade History finishes the historical narrative begun in Grammar school, while building the skills they will need for future history courses. As well as being taught from a biblical worldview, this class sets the foundation for independent Bible study through Biblical literacy and memorization. The ideal candidate for this position will be at home in both disciplines. Moreover, all Covenant teachers serve as pastors (shepherds) of our students, advising them in their walk with Jesus Christ.

This is a full-time, ten-month position (exempt), and will report to the Logic School Director.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree or higher in both History and Bible, or from a program that requires extensive study in both disciplines.
- Proven track record of excellent teaching.
- Experience or interest in classical education and traditional pedagogy.
- Rhetorical excellence in the spoken and written word.

Duties and Responsibilities

Character: Exhibit the fruits of the Spirit, serving as a Christian role model both in and out of school. Set a good example for students, parents, and colleagues in speech, actions, attitude, judgment, dignity, and respect, while living in obedience to God's Word. Consistently exhibit the habits listed in Covenant's Faculty Profile (below).

Instruction:

- Teach four to five sections of middle school history and bible courses, as assigned.
- Demonstrate thorough knowledge of both subjects and lively interest in learning more.
- Integrate a Christian worldview and Covenant's philosophy of education throughout the curriculum.
- Provide an orderly teaching environment, consistently enforcing class rules and school policies and showing good stewardship of classroom materials.
- Teach in an engaging fashion, employing a variety of techniques (lecture, discussion, writing workshop, etc.) that lead to active learning.
- Maintain regular and accurate attendance and grade records.
- Communicate in a wise and effective manner with supervisors, colleagues, students, and parents.
